[0 : 00] Pastor's Reflections, The Source, Genesis 21, 19. And God opened her eyes, and she saw a well of water, and she went and filled.

Zechariah 13, 1. And that day there shall be a fountain, open to the house of David, and to the inhabitants of Jerusalem, for sin and for uncleanness.

1 Corinthians 6, 11. But you are washed, but you are sanctified, but you are justified in the name of the Lord Jesus, and by the Spirit of our God.
