[0:00] A Pastor's Reflections, The Way, Genesis 24, 61-62. And Rebekah arose and her damsels, and they rode upon the camels, and followed the man.

And the servant took Rebekah and went his way. And Isaac came from the way of the well Lachari, for he dwelt in the south country. Proverbs 16, 9. A man's heart devises his way, but the Lord directs his steps. Isaiah 48, 17.

Thus saith the Lord thy Redeemer, the Holy One of Israel, I am the Lord thy God, which teaches thee to profit, which leads thee by the way that thou should go.
